The proposal is to deliver a 1,700-seat performing arts venue in proximity to Brisbane's existing cultural precincts.

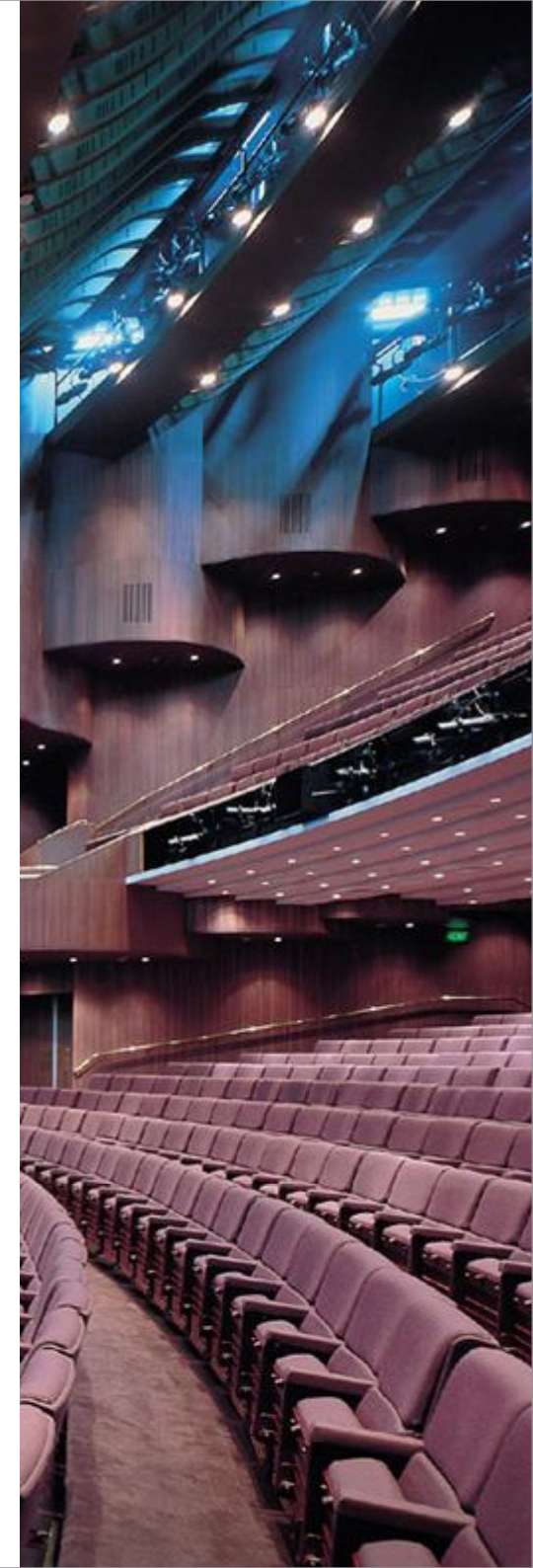
## BENEFITS
